This diploma is made of specially handmade Japanese paper "torinokogami", and the golden fringe symbolizes the lucky bird "ho-o (Japanese phoenix)" and the lucky tree "kiri (paulownia)".

The symbol of three circles means the three circulatory systems in the human body, namely, artery, vein and lymphatic. This was designed by Dr. Nishimaru, the honorary president of the congress, and is the symbol of the Japanese College of Angiology.
